Young Breast Cancer Survivors Share Stories, Offer Words of Wisdom: Part 1

About one in eight U.S. women will develop invasive breast cancer in her lifetime and a man's lifetime risk of breast cancer is about one in 1,000 (BreastCancer.org). But those are all just numbers because, "It's never going to happen to me," right? That's what Bangor-resident Kate Kromer thought, too. She was

37 when diagnosed with breast cancer. Sarah Trimmer of Palmer Township was only 30.

"I had no symptoms and never would have known that I even had cancer had it not been for just losing my mom to pancreatic cancer," Sarah said. "It was my mom's oncologist who suggested I get a genetic test to see if I had a breast cancer cell mutation."

Breast cancer does not discriminate. The truth is, it can happen to you, just as it has to Kate, now 39, and Sarah, 38. "I was your typical, 'It won't happen to me' person," said Kate, who had been having annual mammograms since age 35, due to her very dense breast tissue. Just two years later, she was diagnosed with an aggressive, Stage 3 HER2+ breast cancer.

"Although my type of cancer would not have given any physical warning signs until it was too late, many self exams can detect early signs. And with current treatment plans, when discovered early enough, many breast cancers can be treated with minimal invasiveness.

"Most women don't want to have a mammo done before 40. When a doctor says 'no need,' remember this: I was 37 when I was diagnosed with Stage 3 aggressive cancer. I had 'no need' to get a mammo until I was 40. I could have been dead before 40 if I didn't get a mammo."

So, what if your insurance won't cover a mammogram before age 40?

"Insurance companies assume that the patient will succumb," Kate said. "Push, annoy, have a voice, and be that aggravated and advocated policy holder. I felt like I needed to have a voice for those who did not." Kate has had a double mastectomy, radiation, and will continue chemotherapy until March, along with more reconstructive surgeries.

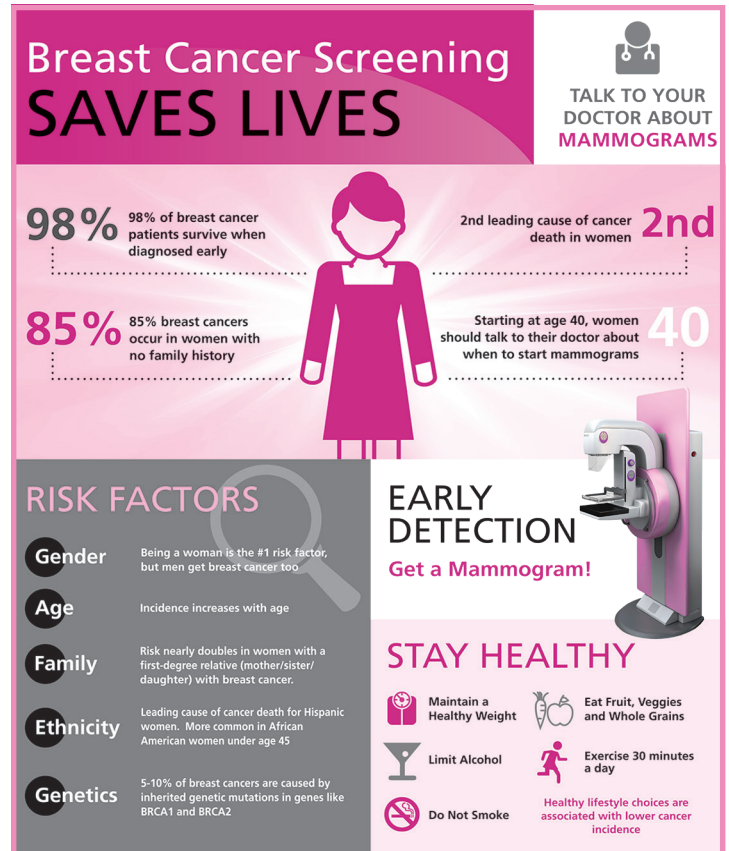
"I never feared death. I lived as a gypsy soul prior to kids. Nothing held me down," Kate said. "Once diagnosed, between working 50-hour weeks, I stared at my living room wall for five days and my kids ate chicken nuggets and frozen pizza. On day six, I had a new attitude. My husband and my kids needed me!"

No matter your driving force in life, Kate stresses the importance of early screenings for both women and men.

"There is a high possibility of detecting early signs of breast cancer and decreasing any chance of recurrence. Early detection can literally change your life span and your

appreciation of what life has to offer."

Like Kate, Sarah Trimmer never would have known she had cancer, had it not been for her mother's oncologist suggesting genetic testing. Read Sarah's story in the next issue of The Belt and Beyond. In the meantime, schedule your annual mammogram!

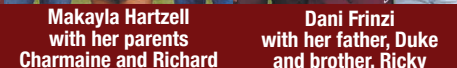
