Slate Belt Branch of the Greater Valley YMCA Breaks Ground for New Pool, Gymnasium, and Child Care Wing

The Slate Belt Branch of the Greater Valley YMCA breaks ground for the construction of a heated indoor pool, basketball gymnasium and childcare wing. The Slate Belt additions are made possible because of the support of many generous gifts from local donors, Foundations, and telling me how his father, John, talked about this plan in the late 1970s community partners. The expansion's anticipated completion is 2020.

A key community supporter, Pennsylvania State Representative Marcia Hahn, helped make the expansion become a reality for the community. Hahn helped the Y secure \$5,000,000 in crucial funding for the project. The funding became available by the State Legislature through passing House Bill 271, which expands gambling in the state. Through this bill, the Y was able to secure funding from Pennsylvania casinos for the expansion of the Slate Belt Branch.

State Representative Hahn (R-Bushkill Township), shares, "The funding is generated solely by the Casinos Local Share Account, so

no taxpayer dollars are directly used in supporting these grants. I sat in on discussions about the pool and gymnasium almost 20 years ago as a member of then-State Rep. Craig Dally's staff. I also remember him when he was mayor of Pen Argyl."

David Fagerstrom, President and CEO of the Greater Valley YMCA shares, "This is an exciting moment for our community. It took patience and years of persistence, but I'm proud to see this project come to fruition. This expansion will enable the YMCA organization to serve the residents of the Slate Belt so much better than we can now. It is exciting to think of how many thousands of people a full-facility YMCA will be able to serve once completed now and well into the future." The addition of the basketball gymnasium, pool and childcare wing will allow the Y to serve many more individuals through life-saving swim lessons, helping seniors stay active and independent, and preparing children socially and academically for success in kindergarten and their futures.

Other key contributors to the Slate Belt Expansion Project are The John and Margaret Post Foundation, The John Jr. and Michael Rohall Jr. Foundation of the Community Foundation of New Jersey, The Wind Gap Chevrolet Buick Foundation, and Lafayette Ambassador Bank. As the project moves forward, the YMCA will host a grand re-opening and ribbon cutting to highlight the new pool, gymnasium, and childcare wing. The Y's Slate Belt Canvassing Committee is currently working to secure the rest of the necessary funding; pledging and naming opportunities are available now.

Tradition Continues in Roseto at the 126th OLMC Big Time Celebration

To everyone else, the Roseto "Big Time" may be just another carnival. It's an opportunity for parents to take their small children to play games and ride the Ferris Wheel, for teens to get together with friends during summer break, and for families to enjoy sausage and peppers, pizza frita, and meatball sandwiches.

But for the tight-knit Italian community of Roseto, the Our Lady of Mt. Carmel (OLMC) Celebration, more commonly known as The Big Time, is a tradition based in faith, honoring the Virgin Mary.

"When I drive up the hill and see the celebration flags, it brings a feeling of peace," said Linda Basso, OLMC Parish Secretary and member of the Queen's Committee. "To see our church, our little cathedral on the hill, standing so strong year after year is just such a blessing."

This year marks the 126th OLMC Celebration, which takes place **July 24th through 27th.**

"[The Big Time] is about family heritage, tradition, and pride for our town," said Amanda Impeciati, 2007 Celebration Queen. "I hope the tradition continues and the younger generation is just as dedicated to working hard."

High school senior girls who are members of OLMC at 11:45pm on Saturday a may run for Celebration Queen by selling raffle tickets for begin at 2pm on Sunday. the annual church fundraiser. Whomever sells the most

tickets earns the title of Celebration Queen. This year's queen is Sophia Genteel and the princess is Kendall Decker.

When 1995 Celebration Queen JoeAnn Impeciati Comunale ran, selling tickets was a family effort.

"We were on a mission," JoeAnn said. "Once a week a meeting was held at my grandmother's house to see how everyone was doing with their sales. If you didn't meet your quota, you were in big trouble," JoeAnn laughed. "My family, they were amazing; the love, loyalty and dedication was astonishing. Being queen meant something to all of us. It wasn't just about me."

With the hard work of her relatives, JoeAnn raised an incredible \$15,000 for OLMC. A family member even won the raffle that year and donated the prize money back to the church.


"Crowning of the Big Time Queen is always wonderful," Linda Basso said. "That young lady crowning the statue of our Patroness, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel--the true Queen of our parish--on Sunday before the Procession is the true meaning of our annual tradition!" Linda said.





The 10U Lehigh Valley Steel is a tournament team made East Brandywine which they fell short of their goal, but still up of kids that participate in the Lehigh Valley Cal Ripken Rec league which covers the Pen Argyl, Bangor, Bushkill Twp, parts of Nazareth, and Freemansburg areas. 
