Gladys Amanda Reichard: the plucky Slate Belt school teacher who lived among the Navajo people in the 1920's and became a famous anthropologist. Portrayed by Melissa Hough.

John Shultz: also known as Shebo Schultz because he befriended a hobo named Shebo and gave him food at night. John was a star halfback for Pen Argyl High School in 1922. Went on to play collegiate football for Temple and professional football for the Philadelphia Yellow Jackets (a forerunner to the Eagles). Portrayed by Jim Paynter.

Jane Bennett Stoddard Frutchey: who knew way too much about the slate quarry families and struck out on her own in the 1900's. Portrayed by Cheryl Stathem.

Mary Gertrude Smith Boddie: raised in East Bangor, she was the first African American female to graduate from East Stroudsburg Normal School, now East Stroudsburg University. Portrayed by Veronica Xaio.

Master of Ceremonies will be Jason Huggan.

Original Main St. Market Owner Will Re-Open Store, Provide for Community, Save Jobs

By Sarah Janelle Loren Bangor was abuzz with excitement on September 9 when it was announced in a

press release that Main St. Market would be re-opening next month by Duane and Nichole Smith. Duane originally founded the downtown-Bangor grocery store in 1995, along with the late Dan Paul. "This is [Duane's] passion," Nichole said. "He isn't a newcomer. He knows the customers and he knows the town."

Duane described the re-opening as "perfect timing," as he had been itching to get back into the industry.

"I thought it was a longshot, but it happened," Duane said.

Nichole added, "It was meant to be."

Along with Duane's love of the grocery business, he and Nichole share a love of their community, which is why they decided to re-open the market.

"Our number one goal was to provide for the community and bring the employees back," Nichole said. "When they cried as they were leaving, I had tears in my eyes." Nichole was present at the market often during its remaining days last month.

"Before it closed, I was getting phone numbers because I knew this could be a possibility," Nichole said. "We got most of the employees back. We didn't even interview, we just called them... and asked if they wanted their jobs back because they're experienced, they're loyal." While the community has been positive since news broke of the market's re-opening, some have shared negative thoughts regarding the closing.

"Nobody was forced out," Nichole said. "There was nothing mean about any of this. Some people just don't know the facts."

More good news comes though, as Duane says there will "absolutely" be an on-site butcher. One of the many perks of the locally-owned and operated grocery store was its fresh, low-cost meats.



On July 20, 2019, the Fr. DeNisco Council (#3862) of the Knights of Columbus, located in Bangor, concluded its "baby bottle" fundraiser for the Cay Galgon Life House raising a total of \$5,678.

Thanks to the generosity of the parishioners of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Roseto, and St. Elizabeth of Hungary, Pen Argyl, the council collected over 300 pounds of checks, bills and coins between Mother's Day and Father's Day. Chairman Miller stated, "This is the first time we participated in this campaign and frankly, we were astounded by people's generosity."

Although their name has recently changed from Mary's Shelter, the mission of the Cay Galgon Life House remains the same. They provide limited-term residential support to pregnant women and mothers with newborns who would otherwise be without housing. In this stable environment, moms participate in counseling and are required to develop skills necessary for independent living. The Cay Galgon Life House also provides non-residential services to over 500 low-income women and children in the community each year through items such as food, clothing, diapers, formula and furniture.

Watch for the Spotted Lanternfly

The spotted lanternfly is an invasive planthopper native to China, India and Vietnam. It was first discovered in Pennsylvania in Berks County and has spread to 13 other counties, including Northampton.

In addition to damaging trees and affecting quality of life, the spotted lanternfly threatens billions of dollars of economic impacts and thousands of jobs for those in the agriculture industry.

Northampton County is currently in a quarantine zone. The general quarantine restricts movement of any material or object that can spread the pest. This includes firewood or wood products; brush or yard waste; remodeling or construction materials and waste; packing material like boxes; grapevines for decorative purposes or as nursery stock; any outdoor household articles like lawnmowers, grills and tarps; and any other equipment, trucks or vehicles not stored indoors.

Businesses in the quarantine area need to obtain a Certificate of Limited Permit from the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture in order to move articles. Failure to comply can lead to criminal and civil penalties.

As citizens, we can also play a role in dealing with this insect. All Pennsylvanians are encouraged to watch for the spotted lanternfly and note the following suggestions:

- If you see eggs: Scrape them off the tree or smooth surface, double bag them and throw them in the garbage, or place the eggs in alcohol or hand sanitizer to kill them.
- If you collect a specimen: Turn the adult specimen or egg mass into the Ag Department's Entomology Lab for verification. First, place the sample in alcohol or hand sanitizer in a leak proof container.
- If you take a photo: Submit photos of adults or egg masses to badbug@pa.gov.
- To report a sighting: Call 1-888-4BAD-FLY (1-888-422-3359) with details of the sighting and your contact information. You can also report sightings online at www.agriculture.pa.gov.

PROPERTY TAX/RENT REBATE PROGRAM DEADLINE EXTENDED

Older adults and Pennsylvanians with disabilities have until December 31, 2019 to apply for the state's Property Tax/Rent Rebate program. The original deadline was June 30, 2019. The program benefits people age 65 or older, widows and widowers age 50 or older, and the disabled 18 or older. The income limit is \$35,000 a year for homeowners and \$15,000 for renters, and half of Social Security income excluded. The maximum standard rebate is \$650.
