



None of us will ever forget the events of these past months. No one could have predicted that our lives would be changed in such a profound way. We have all had to adapt, and it has not been easy.

We are advised repeatedly that, on a physical level, the best way to protect ourselves against the COVID-19 virus is to get vaccinated, mask up and practice social distancing.

But how do we protect ourselves from the unseen effects of this life-altering pandemic? COVID-19 has turned our world upside down. We've collectively experienced fear, anxiety and sadness.

Yet, despite these trying times, we can find reasons to be thankful. And we should. Gratitude is a core aspect of resiliency and helpful in times of crisis.

This Thanksgiving, let us remember how special, beautiful, and blessed our lives are even when we are faced with situations that are uncertain or unpredictable.
