





Nine-Year-Old Bangor Wrestler **First Female Champ** at VEWL

One girl and 33 boys were finalists at the Valley Elementary Wrestling League Championships on February 10th. Wrestling is a predominantly-male sport, but nine-year-old Hailey Mintz didn't let that stop her from making history at the Varsity VEWL. Now, Hailey isn't just the first female to reach the Varsity VEWL finals; she's also the first female to win first place. "She had this goal all season. Right from the beginning..." said Hailey's mom, Paula Mintz. "Halfway through [the season], one of the coaches said no girl has ever won.



the Varsity VEWL. Then this goal was even more important to her." Hailey, of Mt. Bethel, is a second-year varsity wrestler for the Bangor Junior Slaters and this isn't the first time she's made history. Last year, she was the first female to win a PA Junior Wrestling title. "We are so proud of her for meeting her goal and accomplishing this," Paula said. "Her ultimate goal is to get to the Olympics. It's tough, especially as these boys get bigger, but she puts a lot of effort into it. In addition to the Bangor Slaters, Hailey is a member of two wrestling clubs where she trains five days a week and wrestles year-round. The next major events she will be competing in are War at the Shore and the Viper Pit Duals, both national tournaments held in April. Hailey is a force to be reckoned with, currently undefeated against 41 boys in her weight class. This comes as no surprise, as Hailey is on a team of determined wrestlers coached by Bill Lindsay, who was named 2019 Coach of the Year at VEWL. Bangor was one of 36 teams that competed at VEWL, where six Slaters placed at finals, including Hailey's older brother, Tyler. Tyler placed second, Gavyn Kelton third, Carter Smith and Aidan McNulty fourth, and Michael Fuller seventh in their respective weight classes. With all those wins, the Bangor Junior Slaters were named 2018-19 VEWL Dual Meet Champions. Lindsay has been coaching the Bangor Junior Slaters for 18 years This year, for the first time in history, Lindsay led Bangor to become Southwest Division Champions. They also placed first at the Fall Brawl and Stroudsburg Winter Tournament, second at The Duel of the Den, and fourth at the Downingtown Thunder Duals.


